Sir,

In continuation to the Department's letter of even No. dated 29.04.2013 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the college with respect to the proposals submitted to the Central Government as cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the C.C.I.M. in terms of the provisions of the IMCC Act 1970, relevant regulations of the CCIM and approved norms for 2013-14 academic session, which were circulated to all colleges, universities and State Governments and also available on Department's website <indianmedicine.nic.in>; permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the Yashwant Ayurvedic College Post Graduate Training Research Centre, Kodoli, Kolhapur, Maharashtra, to increase the admission capacity in 03 existing PG courses namely (i) Rog Nidan - from 2 to 6 seats, (ii) Shalakyta Tantra - from 2 to 6 seats and (iii) Agadtantra - from 2 to 6 seats and to start new Post Graduate Course of Study in 04 subjects namely (i) Kriya Shareer, (ii) Dravyaguna Vigyan, (iii) Panchakarma and (iv) Sangyahan with 6 seats in each course, from the session 2013-14 under the provisions of the section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970. Therefore, the college may take admissions for the academic session 2013-14 in increased PG seats and new Courses.

2. This permission for starting of the above-mentioned PG courses and in the increased intake capacity in the above-mentioned PG courses for the first admitted batch of 2013-14 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said seats/courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970.

The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers in each new post graduate department and in the increased intake capacity in the above-mentioned PG courses, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the students in the above-mentioned new courses is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.

4. Further, to obtain the permission for academic session 2014-15 onwards to take admissions in the above said permitted seats/courses, the college shall fulfil all the requirements of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder.




