Kolhapur, Maharashtra** to increase in admission capacity from 80 to 100 seats (20 additional seats) in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2014-15 under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970- reg.

Sir,

In continuation to the Department's letter of even No. dated 19.05.2014 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the college with respect to the proposal submitted to the Central Government as cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of recommendations of the CCIM in terms of the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant regulations made thereunder and approved norms for academic session 2014-15 vide Department's letter No.R.11011/10/2013-EP (IM-1) dated 17.06.2014 (available on Department's website <www.indianmedicine.nic.in>); permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the **Yashwant Ayurvedic College Post Graduate Training & Research Centre, Kodoli, Tal. Panhala, Dist. Kolhapur, Maharashtra** to *increase the admission capacity from 80 to 100 seats (20 additional seats) in UG course*, from the academic session 2014-15 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970. Therefore, the college may take admissions for the academic session 2014-15.

2. This permission to increase in admission capacity from 80 to 100 seats for the first admitted batch of 2014-15 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against this course appear for the first final examination of the said course and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970.

Further, to obtain the permission for academic session 2015-16 onwards to take admissions in the above said permitted increase in UG seats, the college shall fulfil all the requirements of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder by 31.12.2014 and fulfilment of the conditions intimated by Department vide letter No.R.17011/129/2014-EP (IM-1) dated 18.07.2014 will be verified by the CCIM.




